



# 2015-2016 Registration Schedule

Updated June 3, 2015

The following registration times are applicable for **Fall Term 2015, Winter Term 2016** and the **PGME 2015/2016 Term**, for students taking degree-credit courses.

## IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Students may **access their registration time** on Aurora beginning **Monday, July 6** (or **June 8** for student listed in sections 1 and 2, below).
- Registration times are assigned based on the student's academic unit/program, as at the date registration times are assigned. Students who change faculties after this date will have their time adjusted once admission is completed.
- In the absence of a DGPA, the CGPA is used.
- Aurora will be open for all functions, including registration, 24 hours per day - seven days per week. (subject to minor scheduled and unscheduled outages in off-peak hours)
- All students require a registration time in order to register. Registration times will be assigned to students on the basis of several criteria as per their student status, as noted in the schedule below.
- Once a registration time begins, a student will be permitted unlimited access to the registration system. i.e. There is no 24 hour window.
- Although students may register on weekends, no registration times will begin on the weekend.
- **Space reserves will be effective up to and including August 6. Unused reserved space will be available to students at 9:00 a.m. on August 7.**
- **NOTE: Aurora is unavailable from 8:30 - 9 am Friday August 7**

### 1) Bannatyne Programs: **June 15**

Undergraduate students registering for Dentistry, Dental Hygiene (excluding Direct Entry), Medicine, Pharmacy or Rehab Sciences, and Graduate students registering for MOT, MPT or **MPAS**.

### 2) Faculty of Nursing Year 3 & 4

**June 15 – 19:** Nursing Year 4

**June 22 – 25:** Nursing Year 3

Registration permitted in Nursing courses only; registration in other faculty courses begins **July 20**.

### 3) Advanced Registration Period: **July 8**

Bison Athletes; Accessibility Services Students; Presidents Scholars; Leaders of Tomorrow

### 4) New U1 Students and Direct Entry from High School: **July 13 to July 17**

New from High School and Mature Status admits to U1 and Direct Entry faculties. Registration times will be based on high school averages, out of province admission or Mature Admit status.

**Note:** Returning U1 & Direct Entry from HS students who have **ATTEMPTED** less than 18 credit hours are considered New – ie. receive a High School time ticket.

**5) Returning U of M Students: July 20 to August 6**

Agricultural and Food Sciences; Architecture; Arts; Environment, Earth & Resources; Fine Art; Engineering; Family Social Sciences; Health Sciences; Health Studies; Music; Nursing; Kinesiology & Recreation Management; Science; all Social Work students; University 1.

Registration times will be based on degree grade point average.

**6) Asper School of Business and Human Ecology (see section 5 for Family Social Sciences, Health Sciences, Health Studies): July 20 to August 5**

Registration times will be based on year in program and degree grade point average.

**7) Faculty of Graduate Studies: July 20**

Grad Studies (except Graduate programs in Education, MPT, MOT, MPAS and programs listed in section 14);

**8) Faculty of Education (B.Ed.): July 27 to 31**

Access is based on student number.

**9) Newly admitted external transfers, newly admitted second degree students and visiting exchange students: July 28**

**10) Special students (newly admitted and returning): July 29**

**11) Faculty of Education (PBDE and Grad Studies): Aug 4**

---

**12) Faculty of Law**

**Aug 4:** Part-time Law

**Aug 5:** Year 3 Law

**Aug 6:** Year 2 Law

**13) Visiting Students: August 7**

Unused reserved spaces are made available at 9:00 a.m.
