Normally, the Academic Standing Override is entered in SGASTDN. However, when registration exists in the term that you want to override, you will need to enter the override in SFAREGS.

Step 1

1. Go into SFAREGS
2. Enter term that you want to override, student number, next block
3. Click on Student Term tab
